

ALPHABET (lower case) MATCH GAME:

Print each of the following pages on cardstock.

Cut the cards apart for one set of match cards (2 cards of each letter).

To play the game: Turn cards face side down, mix, and arrange so each card is separate. One player turns two cards over, saying the name/sound of each letter. If the letters match, the player keeps the cards and gets another turn. If the letters don't match, the player turns the cards back over and the next player gets a turn. When all the cards have been matched, the player with the most matches wins. Younger children can say the name of each letter as they turn them over. Those who are older can either say the sound of the letters or a word that begins with the letters. You can even use these cards to spell words that you have learned!
