SMALL GROUP RESOURCE

Big Idea: God wants us to live with Him.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

What do you imagine living in the garden of Eden was like?

What do you think God is looking forward to in Genesis 3:15?

How did God demonstrate His love for Adam and Eve even after they had eaten of the forbidden fruit?

What impact does the curse of Genesis 3:15,16 have on families today? What is the cure for the curse?

What was wrong with Cain's sacrifice? (see Hebrews 11:4, 1 John 3:12, and Jude 1:11 for additional insights)
What are the consequences of sin that show up in Genesis 3 and 4?

What do we learn about God from Genesis 3 and 4?

PRAYER FOCUS:

Ask God to reveal His character to you through His Word. Confess your sin.

Ask to see a clear way out when temptation comes.

Pray for healing and restoration
of your relationship with God and with men.

If anyone in the family uses one of them this week, ask them what God would think of their reasoning.

What did Eve decide to do?
Why did she give some to Adam?
How did their lives change?
Talk about some of the decisions you have made.
Looking back, why were they good or bad decisions?

READ GENESIS 3:21-24


How did God respond?
