SMALL GROUP RESOURCE

Big Idea: God cares about the real you.

SCRIPTURE READINGS:

DISCUSSION ACTIVITY:

Together (or separately, then share) write your own Psalm of Lament and Praise.

This is an exercise from the heart.

Sharing, not perfection, is the goal.

Introduction:

Tell God you are turning to Him for help. Let God know how you are.

Acknowledge your attempt to be honest with Him.

Lament (complaint):

Describe your gripe, worry, or trouble.

Affirm to God that you trust Him

and want His will in your life.

Ask for God's help:

Ask God to help you according to His will. Ask Him to help you and to fight the enemy.

Note your reasons for asking for God's help:

Tell God what could happen to you if He does not intervene.

Acknowledge God's love and care for you:

Express your confidence that God has heard your prayer and has already moved in response to it.

Promise your praise:

Promise to tell others what God has done in your life. so they can see His Goodness.

PRAYER FOCUS:

Ask for willingness to share your concerns with God and with others.

Pray that your will can submit and see God's will.

Thank God that you can trust Him.

Pray for opportunities to tell others as God

shows His care for you.

READ PSALM 139:23-24


Who does David trust to correct him?
