Which of these beatitudes is most important to you right now? Why?

PRAYER FOCUS:

Praise God for truth. Tell God how much you need Him. Thank God for the joy you experience in Him. Ask God to show you where you need to give yourself to His Spirit. FAMILY RESOURCE

READ MATTHEW 5:1-4

What do you think of when you hear "poor"? What do you think of when you hear the word "kingdom"? Look up the word "mourn" in the dictionary, then have a family hug & snuggle session.

READ MATTHEW 5:5-6

Look up "meek" in the dictionary. Why does it take a strong person to be meek? Make up & act out a skit about a hungry person entering the kitchen. What does verse 6 say we are to be hungry for?

READ MATTHEW 5:7-8

How can you help others be kind? How does being honest help me see who God is? Tell each other one thing that someone else did for you today.

READ MATTHEW 5:9

Calmly and patiently work through one family problem until you all agree on the solution. How long did it take? As needed, remind each other of your agreement.

READ MATTHEW 5:10-12

How should we feel if people tell us about the things we've done wrong? Who can make the best sad face? How should we feel if people don't like the things we've done right? Who can make the biggest smile?


MEMORY VERSE:
