Luke 9

1-10 - the twelve "tour"

When you go out, do you expect hospitality/participation? How does expecting hospitality/participation affect those who you are ministering to? What questions about Jesus are others asking because of you? Who are you accountable to for your ministry?

10-17 - the feeding of the 5,000 (see John 6:1-15)

When the people did not participate in their healing or their feeding, how did they react? What changes when we ask/expect people to participate with us?

18-50 – Jesus teaches his followers

18-20 Have you asked anyone who they think Jesus is?

21-27 What does a life that follows Jesus look like?

28-36 What was Peter trying to hold on to?

37-45 - casting out a demon (see Matthew for the disciples' problem)

Vs 41 – Was this a test? The man asks Jesus to look at his son, not to heal him, because Jesus' disciples could not heal him.

How do we deal with disappointment caused by others?

Vs 45 – When are you too afraid to ask questions? Why?

46-50 - Does Jesus promote competition amongst his followers?

51-62 – Partnering with Jesus

51-56 There will be people who want nothing to do with Jesus. What does Jesus do with them?

57-58 When people volunteer, be clear about the cost.

59-60 When it is clear that Jesus has something for you to do, do you make excuses?

61-62 Who or what holds you back from following Jesus?
