

Turn your Desert into a Dessert!

Props:

Make the following 6 letters on cardstock (8 ½ x 11 or larger) for each of 6 participants to hold up. When standing in order they spell DESERT. On the back of each card you may write/glue their "one-line" dialog or the whole skit, highlighting their part. This allows for a quick, easy production.

D - Boy, it sure is hot!

E - I can't believe I'm here!

S - I'm uncomfortable with the whole thing!

E - Can't I get a break?

R - Nothing like this has ever happened to me before!

T - I'd do anything to be somewhere else!

There is one other "main" actor (the Savior) who should have on a T shirt with a big S on the front. Cover this with a jacket for the first part of the skit. He should also have a carry bag with 6 bottles of water that can be quickly accessed.

SKIT:

6 cardholders struggle from their seats up to the stage area as if they are making their way through the desert. (Hopefully, some will really ham it up!) They can make up their own actions and dialog for this. When they are standing in order (spelling DESERT to the audience) they begin saying their "one-liners".

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BIG S enters the scene. - Hey, you guys took off without me! (starts to pass out the water) I'd really like to make this a team effort. I brought enough water for each of you for the entire trip. Now, let's see, where should I be? I think right here would be just about right. (Positioning himself in the middle between the S and the E.)

At this point BIG S opens his jacket to reveal the S. (Note: with the other letters this spells DESSERT.) Together all the other letters sigh, then say "Our SAVIOR".

BIG S - Now, if you'll all just follow me, I have a real TREAT in store for you!

BIG S takes off, leading the other letters offstage with him.

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
