What difference does that make to the story?
Romans 10:1-14 and Matthew 10:26-39
What does it mean to confess Jesus as Lord?

What is the relationship between faith and confession? What is the relationship between baptism and confession?

What does God want us to do in response to desiring a relationship with Him?
What do you still need to do?
What do you need to continue doing?

PRAYER FOCUS:

Praise God for His grace.

Agree with God about your need to depend on Him rather than yourself.

Thank God for providing us with examples to follow. Ask God to show you your next step of faith.

READ 2 CORINTHIANS 5:17


What can we expect to happen when we repent & are baptized?
