DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

How does God show His faithfulness to Joseph through all of these events?

How does Joseph show his faithfulness to God through all these events?

How does unfaithfulness impact our world?

Why are people so reluctant to make commitments?

How would your family be different if every member of the family was faithful?

What or who is at the root of faithfulness? (Think about the opposite. What or who is at the root of unfaithfulness?)

What would need to change in your life to have you growing into a more faithful person?
What commitments have you made that you are not keeping? How would a greater focus on the Holy Spirit change that situation?

Praise God for His faithfulness
Agree with God about times when you have been unfaithful
Thank God for times when His Spirit has produced in you
faithfulness beyond your capability
Ask God to give you the strength to keep the commitments
you have made

for your next meal.


READ GENESIS 45:4-11



CRAFTS:

Start a plant from seed. How faithful can you be in watering/growing it? What changes will occur in the plant (outgrow the pot, plant in yard, frost, etc.) that you will need to be ready for?

Blow up and decorate (felt pens) a balloon as a person. Give it a "coat of many colors" just like Joseph had. Make cardstock feet for your balloon and tape the "tied" end to it so it can stand up.

Use playdough to make colorful clothing.

FAMILY ACTIVITIES:

Have each family member talk about one hard choice they had to make that day. What made it a hard choice? How did they feel after they made their choice?

Tell each other the things that you have completed that day. God is happy when we complete what needs to be done.

Make a promise at the first of the week that each of you will do by next Sunday.

Make it a family goal to be ready and on time for everything this week! You'll have to work hard on your schedule and everyone will have to be willing to work together.

Make a salad in a watermelon "basket" and give it away.
