



FAMILY ACTIVITIES:

Notice where people get together and talk. What kinds of things do they talk about? How, when, and where do you talk about God?

Play twister—gently!

CRAFTS:

Make a person out of a hard boiled egg, a banana ... (olive slices, small carrots, etc.) then eat it?

Use egg shells or macaroni/pasta and gently glue them onto a paper in the shape of a cross. How gently does God treat us?

GAMES:

What's in the bag? Place several different items in different brown lunch bags (number the bags) and see which ones the kids can identify. Kids can write or draw on a list next to the #'s. (Make some of the items delicate - a cookie, sandwich, ribbon, etc.) Open the bags to find out what was in them and how the things survived. How gentle were we?

Balloon volleyball. Can we really play without breaking the balloon?

Egg peel contest - Who can peel a hard boiled egg with the fewest dents?
