DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Why must goodness be a fruit of the Spirit?
What happens when we attempt to achieve goodness on our own?

Where is the Holy Spirit working on goodness in your life?

Prayer Focus:

Praise God for His goodness (holiness).

Agree with God about the contaminated areas of your life.

Thank God for the growth in goodness
that you have seen in your own life.

Ask God to send His Spirit into areas of your life
that need to be cleaned up.

Make up a song or cheer to remind you of your choice/s.



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CRAFT:

Make a spinner out of a paper plate, cardstock arrow, & brad. For younger kids mark the plate in just two parts - good & bad. for older kids you might add "ok", "maybe", "I want to", etc. Do we make choices by spinning?

GAMES:

Play follow the leader. We need to be examples of goodness.

Bob for apples. (Get your snack this way?)

Shoebox shuffle - cut holes in the tops of shoeboxes (or use tissue boxes!) so that they can be walked in. Make one set for each team. Set up a relay with each person on a team leaving and then coming back, trading the shoes with the next person, etc. Making bad choices is like wearing shoeboxes instead of shoes. It slows us down!

Have older kids break off into groups and come up with a pantomime that has one of them making a difficult choice. Have them act out the pantomime twice. The first time with a bad choice made, the second with a good choice made.

Play FRUIT BINGO. Play FRUIT MATCH.

FAMILY ACTIVITIES:

Hearts can change when you are good to others. Can you think of something good you can do for someone who doesn't deserve it?

Work extra hard to keep each other honest. Make up a family signal that will remind you to "check your truth".

Have each family member think of a challenge or problem that another family member is facing. They are to tell them that they are aware of the problem and tell them a specific way that they would like to help.


Goodness includes using what God gives you to help others. Put a coin jar out on the table and see how fast you can fill it up this week with your change. As a family, decide how/where you want to give it.
