DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Why is love listed first in the fruit of the Spirit?

What were the new Christians doing and why were they doing it?

What changed in the church to create this situation?

What did they do to restore love?

What could you do to become a more loving church?

PRAYER FOCUS:

Praise God for being love.

Agree with God about your lack of love.

Thank God for the love you receive from Him and others.

Ask God for a stronger sense of His love through the presence of the Holy Spirit.





Do you know what it takes to love another person?

We have to have something to give!

We all have more than we need in time and things.

God wants us to grow in our giving to others.

Sharing and giving is the key to loving others.

FAMILY ACTIVITIES:

Talk about who you have trouble (or are uncomfortable) being with. How can you show them God's love?

Make a fruit salad and share it with your neighbors.

Work at noticing more people around you by playing the game "I SEE......". "I see 3 people in that car"; "There are 10 people in the park"; etc. Challenge each other to see who noticed how many people WERE where you just left.

CRAFTS:

Make a tic-tac-toe board using hearts and strawberries for markers.

Make food/s out of playdough and arrange them on a plate.

PRESCHOOL BIBLE STORY:

The Bible (open Bible in your lap) tells us that, after Jesus rose from the dead and went to heaven, the people who loved Jesus did a lot of things together. What are some of the things you like to do together?....

Yes, these people would play together and work together and eat together. Everyone was loving each other and taking care of each other.... UNTIL (pause)...some people started to complain. What do you think they complained about?....

Well, here's what the Bible says happened. There were people who came to eat together, but some of them were going away hungry. (Move to sit at one table.) The people who sat at this table got served food first. (Move to sit at another table.) There wasn't any food left for the people that sat here. The people loved each other and wanted to fix the problem. They didn't want anyone going hungry. What do you think they did?

They picked 7 people who could be sure that everyone had food. They prayed for those 7 people. They asked God to give them wisdom so they could be fair in sharing the food. With God's help, everyone was fed. People that were watching them wanted to know about Jesus because they could see that these people really loved each other.

DURING SNACKTIME:

Ask how the food should be served. You could pretend to run out of food before serving some of the kids. Use this to let the kids know that in the Bible story for today, people run out of food.

GAMES:

Set the table relay (each team has same stuff and they run and set one piece at a time.)

Pantomime ways to help others while others guess what you are doing.

Play fruit bingo.

Play fruit matching game.
