SMALL GROUP RESOURCE

Patient children come from a patient God .

SCRIPTURE READINGS:

Exodus 3 to 7 1 Corinthians 13:4 Ephesians 4:2

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

When these verses describe God's character, what phrase is related to patience? (Exodus 34:6, Numbers 14:18, Nehemiah 9:17, Psalm 86:15, 103:8, 145:8, Joel 2:13, Jonah 4:2, Nahum 1:3)

How would you define patience?

In Exodus 3 to 7 we find the story of God's interaction with Moses prior to the Exodus. What are the excuses that Moses makes for refusing to accept God's call? How does God respond to each excuse? If you were God, how would you respond to Moses? How old were Moses and Aaron when they went to see Pharaoh? (Exodus 7:7)

Why did God wait so long before asking Moses to lead the Israelites? (see Exodus 2:11-15 for one possibility)

How has God demonstrated His patience toward you? What is God preparing you for? How is He preparing you?

What area of your life demands patience the most? Why?

PRAYER FOCUS:

Praise God for His slowness to anger.

Agree with God about your quickness to anger/impatience.

Thank God for His Holy Spirit who produces patience in us.

Ask God for more of the Holy Spirit to deal with situations that are making you angry/impatient.

FAMILY RESOURCE

Why did God get mad at Moses? What jobs need 2 people to do them? Why?

READ EXODUS 7:6-7

Draw a picture of something you've done that you didn't want to do.
Why did you do it?




