SCRIPTURE READINGS & DISCUSSION QUESTIONS Genesis 3:1-24

What is the root cause of unrest and suffering in the world?

How is peacemaking a partnership? Is peacemaking necessarily peaceful?

PRAYER FOCUS

Ask God to help you trust Him with our non-peaceful world.

If you haven't yet, pray to accept God's offer of peace in Jesus.

If you have accepted God's peace, pray to be a peace maker among His people.

If you have accepted God's peace, pray for the faith to accept persecution in your role as a peacemaker. **FAMILY RESOURCE** Big Idea: Peace is trusting and serving Jesus.

Why did Christians want to avoid Saul? Why did Saul want to hurt so many people? Play a game of tag. How do you choose who to tag?

READ ACTS 9:1-9

READ ACTS 9:10-19

How did Ananias feel about Saul before he met him? How did Ananias feel about Saul after he met him? Talk about people you are afraid to meet and why you don't want to meet them.

READ ACTS 9:20-22

Why did people listen to Saul? Work together to make an ad for Jesus.

READ ACTS 9:23-25

Why did the Jews want to kill Saul? Find unusual places in your home/yard where you can hide, then play Hide & Seek.

READ ACTS 9:26-28

How did the disciples overcome their fear of Saul? What can you do to help people stop fearing & fighting each other? What can you do to help others to find peace with God? Make 2 signs, one to remind you not to fear others and another to remind you to trust God.

Trusting God Brings Peace

PEACE The pear represents peace. Because of its shape a pear tends to stay in one place. It is shaped and weighted like one of those boxing bag toys. Though it can be rocked/ hit, it resettles. It is content/solid. Pears are also picked "green" and then they ripen over time - off the tree. Peace often requires that kind of process - taking the time to choose, pursue and deepen a relationship.

Eat some pears. Better yet, SHARE them with someone else!

FAMILY ACTIVITIES:

When anyone starts to worry or whine do the "PEACE" cheer: Gimme a "P" (P!) Gimme an "E" (E!) Gimme an "A" (A!) Gimme an "C" (C!) Gimme an "E" (E!) What does that spell? PEACE, PEACE, "GOD GIVES PEACE!

Make a "peace man" using a balloon & attaching cardstock feet. What would a "peace" hero look like? Have kids pantomime something that scares them and have the others guess who/what it is. Ask for suggestions as to how to stop being afraid.

Make scary people/monsters out of playdough. Why are we afraid of them? OR make sources of light - candle, flashlight, sun, etc.

Bible Verse in sign: But the fruit of the spirit is love, joy, **PEACE...** the sign shows that agreement makes life smoother.

GAMES:

Set up an obstacle course and go through it blindfolded. Then have a person give you vocal directions as you go through. Next have a person lead you through by the hand. Which do you find more peaceful?

Play What/Who is in the basket? (What you put in the basket will depend on how big the basket is!)

When the house is dark, play flashlight tag. (Notice how light effects your eyes.)

Peace relay - divide kids into teams of 2. Give each team an equally long string with each partner holding one end. They roll up the string (over tp rolls or into balls) until their rolls touch. (Peace brings people together, and it can take time and work and thought, and it means FACING the other person, but it is worth it.)
