1-11 – the sabbath

1-5

Why would the disciples, knowing the law and knowing that Pharisees were there, walk through a field AND pick grain on the Sabbath?

What are we apt to do when we have needs?

How do we react to criticism? Are we ready with an answer for WHY we are doing something?

6-11

Who do you feel is watching you closely? Do you know why?

What was the man's need? Why did Jesus meet his need?

Have you done anything publicly to prove a point? Is it more important to make a point or to make a difference?

12-16 – who?

What does the term "apostle" mean?

Who have you chosen to be around?

What are you passing on?

17-49 - instruction

17-19 What would it be like to be in the middle of that crowd?

20-26 - advice

What advice is Jesus giving to his disciples?

27-38 – be merciful like God

Who do you love?

Who do you show mercy to?

Who do you judge?

Who do you forgive?

Who are you generous with?

Now put GOD in each of those questions. I.E. - Who does God love?

39-49 - parables

39-42 – We need someone who can see more clearly than we can.

There are supposed to be people ahead of us and behind us in our path while following Jesus.

What does it take to be a mentor/leader?

How do we know if we are teaching well?

43-45 – What's inside comes out. We need to deal with the inside.

Why should we pay attention to what comes out of our mouth? Out of others' mouths?

46-49 – We need practice/action/to demonstrate trust

When is your action based on trust in God?

When is your action based on self-help or self-desire?
