Big Idea: God wants your heart.

Why did the people of Israel want a king?  
Why did God give them a king?  
1 Samuel 10  
Why did God choose Saul?  
What does Saul do after he is appointed king?  
How do the people respond to Saul?  
What does this tell you about God's choice?  
1 Samuel 13:1-15  
What is the situation in Israel when Saul becomes king?  
How effective is Saul as a leader?  
Why does God so quickly tell Saul that his son will not be king after him?  
What is Saul's great mistake?  
What situation are you confronted with where you are tempted to make the same mistake?  
1 Samuel 15  
What is God's clear instruction to Saul?  
What does Saul do?  
How does Saul respond when confronted by Samuel?  
What does God desire from Saul? (1 Samuel 15:22,23)  
Has God changed, or does He still desire this from us?  
What are your burnt offerings and sacrifices?  
What does God desire from you?  
What is God's greatest desire for a leader of His people?

### PRAYER FOCUS:

Praise God for being your King.  
Agree with God about your disobedience of His clear instruction.  
Thank God positive examples of how to follow God.  
Ask God for specific guidance and an obedient heart.

Why were the Israelites afraid?

Why did Saul make the offering?

Why wouldn't Saul remain king?

Play "follow the leader".

How long can you play before you want to be the leader?

### READ 1 SAMUEL 15:1-3 & 7-26

What did God tell Saul to do?

What did Saul do?

Why was God disappointed in Saul?

What did God really want from Saul?

Write each of the letters of OBEY on a piece of paper.

Write/draw things on the papers that start with that letter.

With all of the distractions, can you still spell "obey"?

Rewrite 1 Samuel 15:22 in your own words.

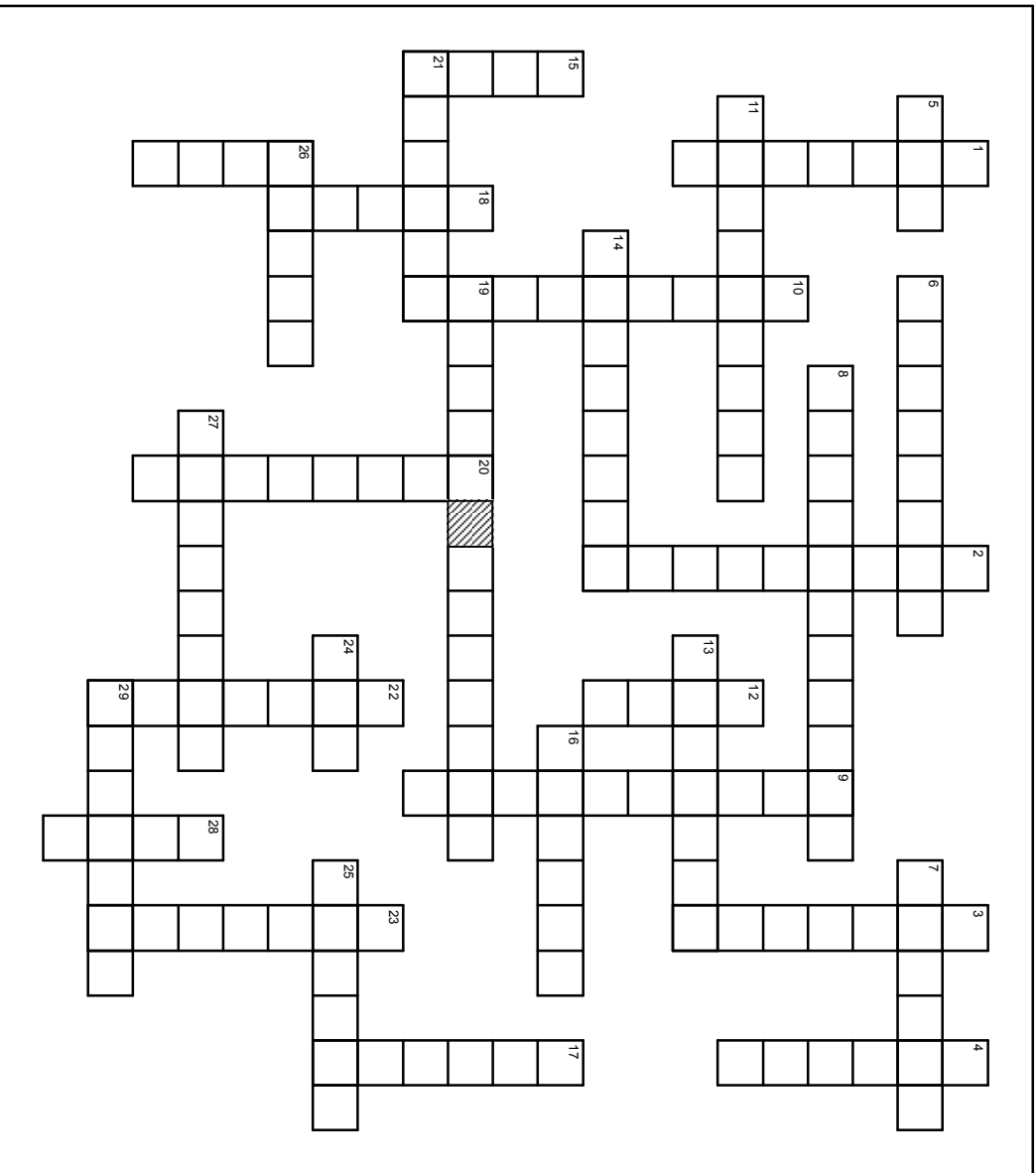

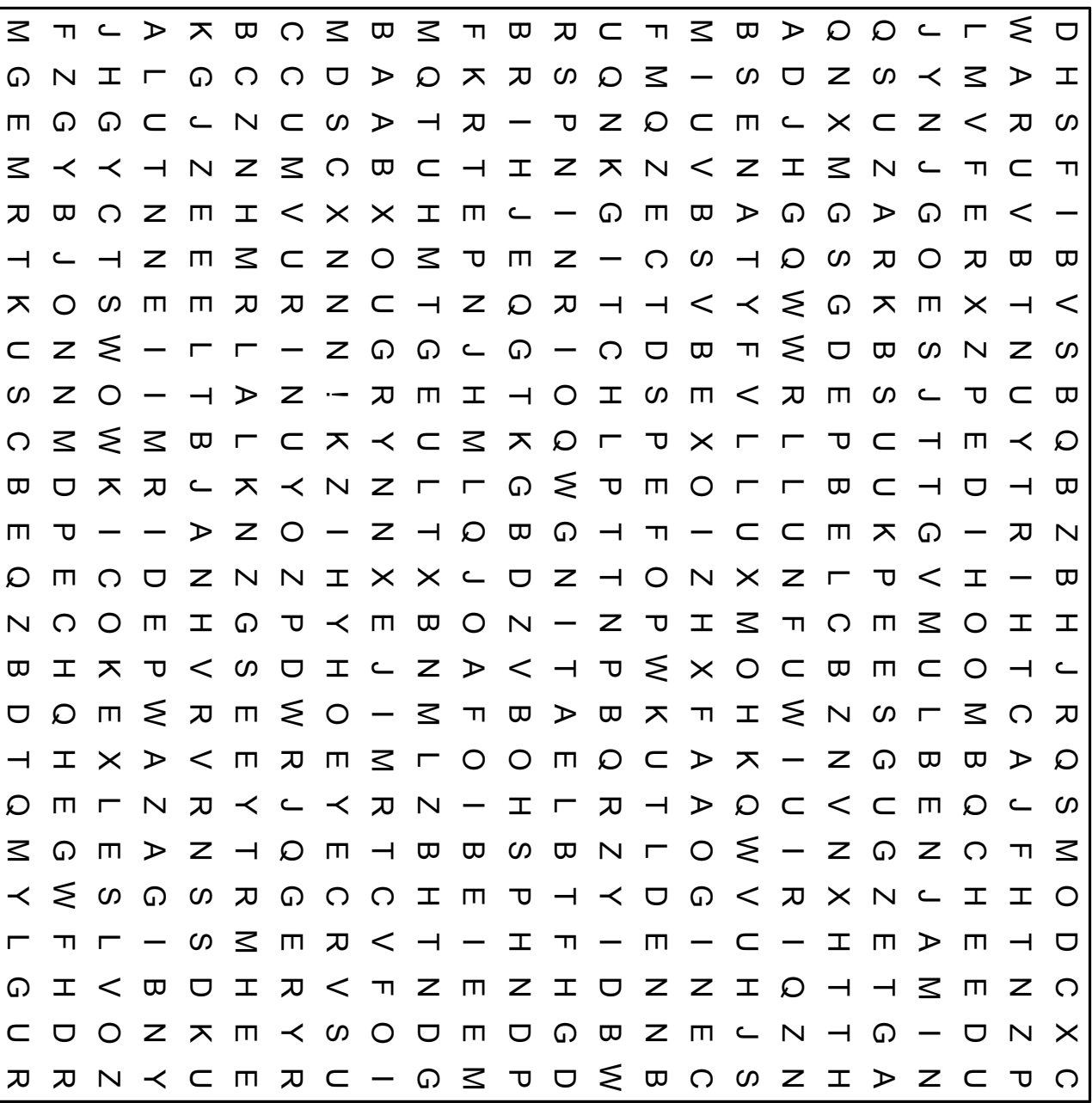
