Take a bath and put on clean clothes.

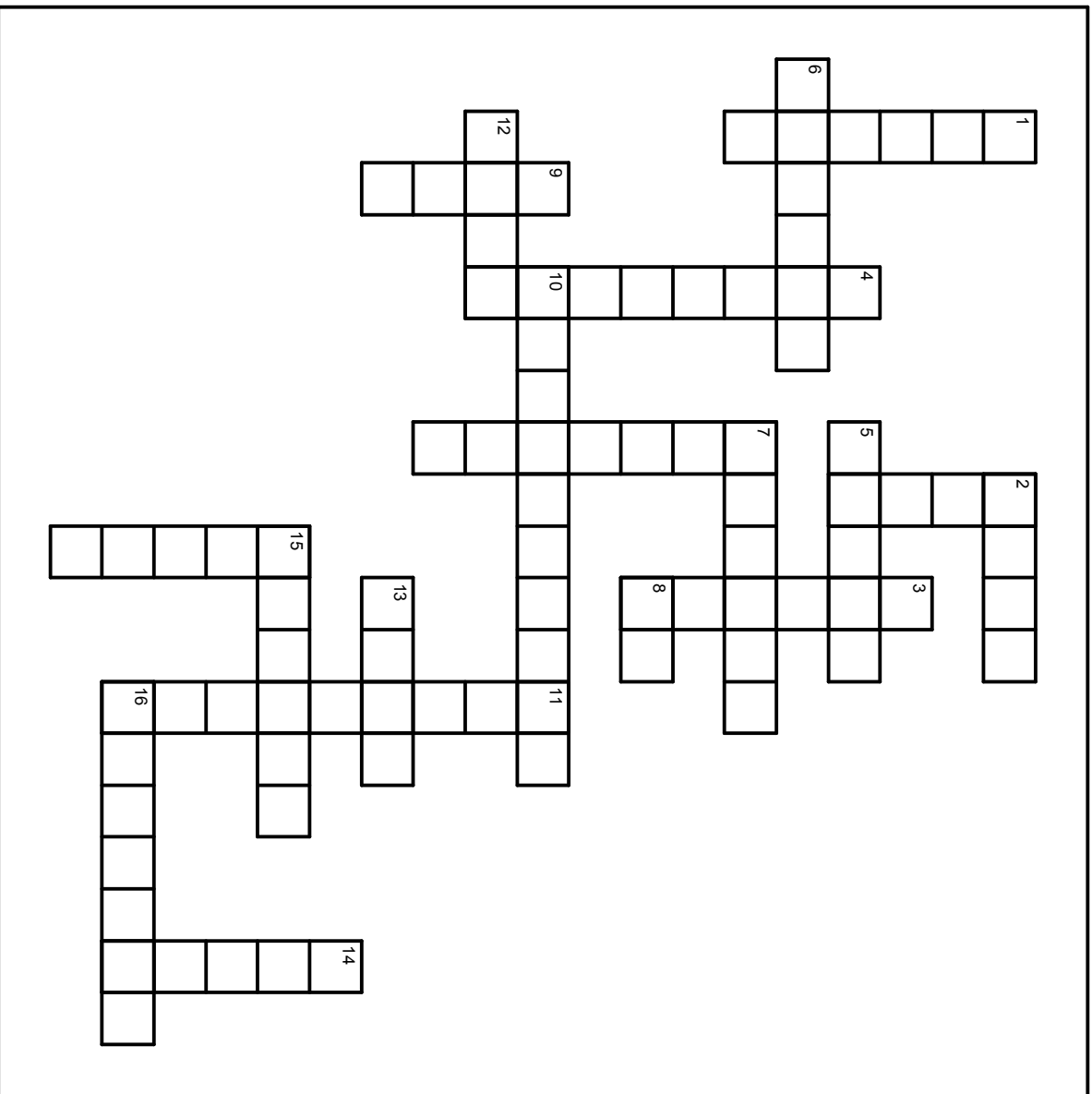
READ ISAIAH 6:8-9

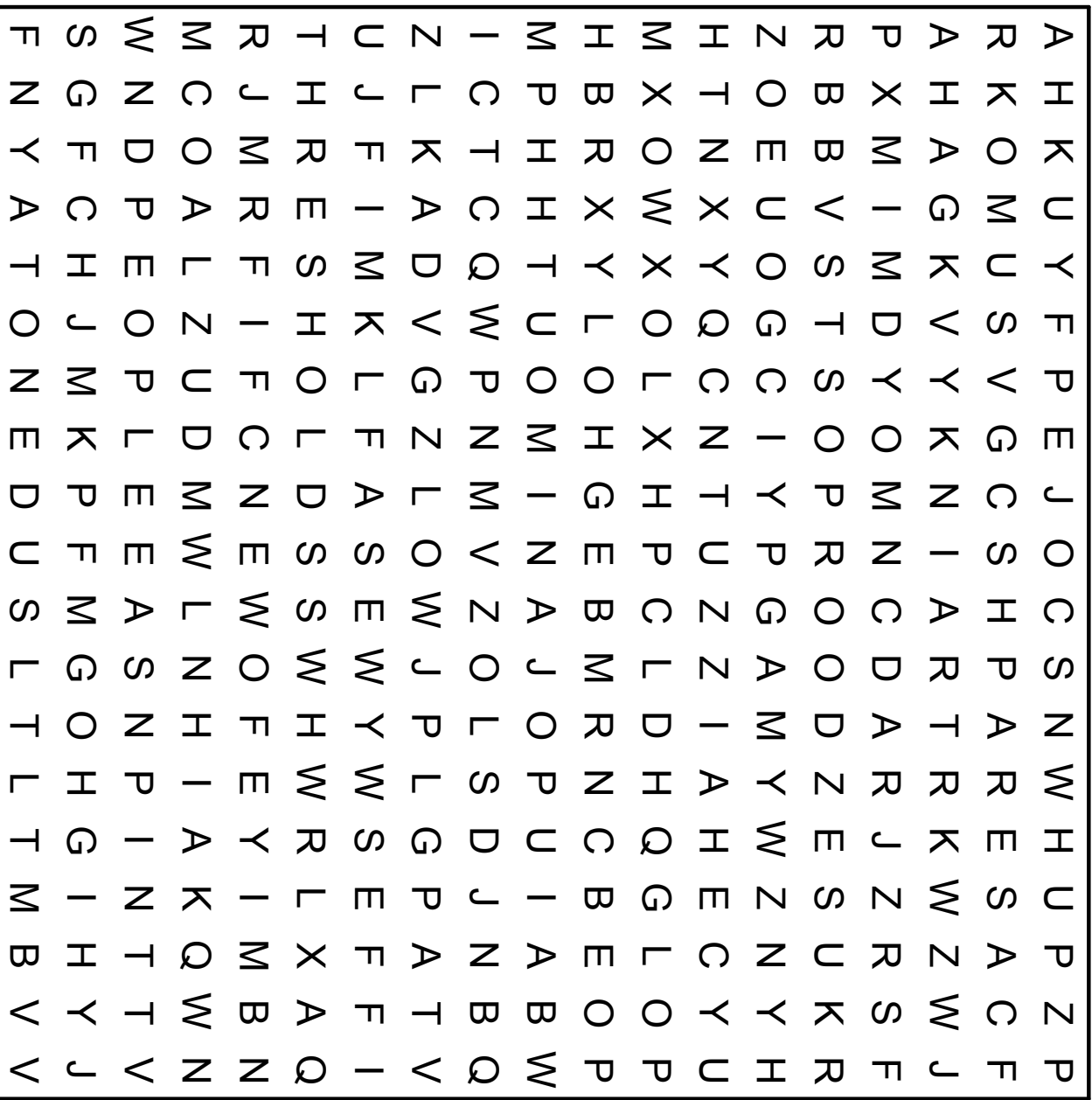
