## LUKE TEAM MEMORY VERSE:

What better way to demonstrate teamwork and the results it can bring than to do our memory verse for the Luke series (in our small groups, classes, and in the Sunday AM church service) as a team?

The concept is that each week the small group or class leader cuts apart each line of the memory verse and hands each section to a member of their group/class. (If necessary, people could be given more than one part.) The instructions can be something like this:

- You will need to be on time because the memory verse team will perform right after the opening prayer with no
  introduction. So, # 1 really needs to be ready to "go". The rest will follow.
- You are to <u>memorize</u> your section of the verse and know where it goes. Please stand to say it and remain standing until the entire verse has been completed. You'll know this because the last part is the scripture reference (I John 3:16-18). Then you may all be seated.

For the Sunday AM worship services during the Spring Training events, a different life group can be selected to "perform" the memory verse each week. That way their "team" can practice and work on their presentation.
