## Where is he?

Thematic uses: City of refuge; God's pursuit of us; Church's role in reconciliation;

## Cast:

Person 1 – the runner

Person 2 – the pursuer – sits in the front row until needed

Persons 3, 4, 5 – seekers/helpers in the audience

Runner runs across (or in front of) the stage as he says "He's after me!"

Person 3 stands up from audience after runner has left the stage, looks around, and says "Where did he go?" (person 3 sits back down)

Runner runs across (or in front of) the stage as he says "I've just got to get away!"

Person 4 stands up from audience after runner has left the stage and says toward person 3 "I haven't seen him!" (person 4 sits back down)

Runner runs across (or in front of) the stage as he says "I can't keep this up much longer!" Person 5 stands up from audience after runner has left the stage and says to #'s 3 & 4 "I'll help you look for him!" (person 5 sits back down)

Runner runs across stage and the pursuer stands up from the front row, causing them to come face to face.

Persons 3,4, and 5 stand up and point and say "There he is!"

Pursuer (not breaking eye contact with the runner, waves to his helpers)...Thank you, my friends. I'll take it from here." (persons 3,4,5 sit down.....to runner) "I've been looking all over for you."

Runner begins backing up and looking for a way of escape as he apologizes. "Hey, man. I'm really sorry, I said I was sorry! I don't know what else I can do!"

Pursuer puts his hand on runner's upstage shoulder to keep him from running away again. "Brother, I know. I forgive you. You look bushed. Let's go find a quiet place to sit down and rest."
