DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Romans 1:8-17

Why does Paul want to see the people of Rome in person? Paul clearly believes in the power of the Holy Spirit. Would he still have the same desire to see people “face to face” with all the technology that we have today?

How can a message save anyone? What are examples of “words that save” in other situations?

What is Paul’s obligation in verse 14?

When you think of sharing the gospel, who do you think you are obligated to?

How would your attitude change if you saw your obligation the same way Paul does?

What is the faith that Paul is talking about?

How are the gospel and faith connected?

How does it change your attitude toward faith if you think of it as something you have?

How would you describe your faith?

Where in the world do you see faith that encourages you?

Thank you, Father, that the crucifixion and resurrection are events in history.

Thank you that my faith is built on Jesus and the power of His resurrection.

What, then, shall we say in response to this?


