

This book is designed for family participation during the Christmas season. You can adapt it's use to an existing nativity set or make your own from a pattern of your choice, either making the figures ahead or as you go through the book.

The "cue words" are underneath each picture of the nativity figures.

Say them aloud each time you pass each nativity figure to help you remember the meaning of Christmas.

If you begin this book on December 14th and do one page each day you will finish it on December 25th.

If you want to give yourself time for life's interruptions, start this activity book sometime the first week of December. You can also time things so that the last page is completed on the traditional arrival of the wisemen, January 6.

Share your gifts with family and friends with joy because God has given us THE BEST PRESENT OF ALL!




**ARE YOU READY?**

for Baby Jesus to be born.






**HONOR HIM WITH GIFTS**

Matthew 2:11 (NIV)


God gave us His Best Gift, Jesus. We honor and worship Him when we give Him gifts.






"I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered.

Mary was happy to do what God wanted. She even sang a song of joy. (Luke 2:46-55) Mary reminds us to be willing servants.






**WE SEEK HIM TOO!**

Just as the camels and wisemen searched for the new King, we want to find Jesus and worship Him.






A WILLING SERVANT

Joseph was happy to do what God wanted. He took good care of both Mary and Jesus.






SPREAD THE NEWS!

After they had seen Jesus, they went and told others about what had happened.






THE ADOPTING FATHER


"And she gave birth to her firstborn, a Son.

Jesus was born in a stable to show that He is both our Savior and our Friend.






JESUS, THE LAMB OF GOD



Since Jesus came and died for us, He is our sacrifice for sin.






A DIFFERENT KIND OF KING
